Motion to Read: To add a line item of \$750 in the current admin budget for travel and lodging for the facilitator and Co-Facilitator of the Southeastern Zonal Forum to attend the zonal forum meeting in December to be held in the Carolina Region. These funds would be given to our Regional Delegate to disburse based on actual receipts received from the Facilitator and Co-Facilitator.

Intent: Our zone is in the process of overhauling our guidelines in an effort to provide actual service to the regions in our zone. As a result, the first thing we're doing is going back to a rotation of our zonal meetings. Therefore, a meeting is scheduled for December in Charlotte, NC. The zonal facilitator is from Orlando and will need to travel via air to attend. The co-facilitator is from South Carolina and will drive to attend. They would share a hotel room.

Our current guidelines do not have any provision for the funding of zonal trusted servant attendance. Our proposed guidelines will. We are still formulating these proposed guidelines and will be presenting them at our August RSC. They will not take affect (if adopted by all the regions in our zone), until that December zonal meeting. In the future, our zone will be funded by the donations from our member regions, but until that time, someone needs to step up and pay for zonal expenses. The Florida Region paid for the webinar software. The Carolina Region is paying for the December zonal meeting. The Georgia Region is pairing for the February (2016) zonal meeting. I would like our region to pay for these travel expenses.
