H&I Subcommittee MOTIONS

To change item 11 on page 35 under Vice-Chairperson to say “responsible for conducting orientation and distributing orientation 'dos and do nots' to newly elected panel and co-panel leaders upon their election at monthly subcommittee meeting.”

To change item 13 under H&I Vice-Chairperson to say “maintains and speaker list as a reference point for panel and co-panel leaders; adding members that are cleared to speak in the jail, meet H&I speaker requirements, or no longer meet H&I speaker requirements etc.”

To add to page 35 under Panel Leaders an item 10 that reads “responsible for orienting the speakers they choose prior to the speaking commitment.”

To add to page 36 under Co-Panel leaders an item 8 that reads "responsible for orientating the speakers they choose prior to the speaking commitment.”

To change item 2 page 36 under Speaker requirements to read “Oriented either at H&I subcommittee meeting or by a panel or co-panel leader prior to speaking at a facility.”

To strike item 3 page 36 under Speaker requirements.

To change #1 under #6 on page 37-38 under Additional Guidelines. Have a new item #1 under say “meet all speaker requirements”

To strike the item that is double asterisked (**) on page 36 under Agenda for Monthly Meeting

Intent: To give our trusted panel and co-panel leaders trust and freedom to choose speakers without being required to only choose from speaker list. To allow our panel and co-panel leaders the ability to orientate his or her own speaker(s), prior to them speaking at a facility, based on the orientation panel and co-panel leaders received upon his or her election. We want our panel and co-panel leaders to be a trusted servant of NA. Our subcommittee has elected each panel and co-panel leader to have certain responsibilities, and upon election we are saying we trust his or her ability to find speakers that meet our subcommittee’s speaker requirements and carry an NA message. To have the secretary or H&I maintain the speaker list as point of reference for panel and co-panel leaders seeking speakers, especially those responsible for taking speakers into Collier County Jail because those speakers must also have been clear by the jail and gone through its orientation process.

Pro- We can still use the speaker list.

Pro- Panel and co-panels do not go into facilities alone.
