19. TREASURER REPORT

We started this months Area with a balance of \$5696.11. We took in \$1160.38 in donations and payments to literature. Our monthly expenses totaled \$1165.46. Our outstanding expenses include some checks and a Literature invoice together totaling \$642.91. This leaves us with a total amount of \$927.87 over prudent reserve. A check in that amount was sent to our Region on 4/12/23.

In the expenses column, you will see that we sent a check to Region in the amount of \$360.30 and a payment to World in the amount of \$125.04. YAY US!! Our area is doing a great job serving and financially supporting the local service structure, the Regional services and the NA World!

(Update: Initially we were \$927.87 over prudent reserve so we sent a check to Region for that amount. Then we had two more automatic withdrawal's come out right before this months bank statement closed for two withdrawals amounted to \$155.45 (Zoom=\$15.99(4/11)+CubeSmart \$99.46(4/12) =\$115.45) So now we are \$115.45 under PR instead of having a balance equal to PR (\$4235.70).
