10. Subcommittee Reports:

- **Activities:**

Good morning the Activities Subcommittee meets at 5pm on the last Sunday of the month here at TLC. We've had two monthly meetings which were reasonably well attended by our members.

The Ice Cream Social was held on March during which we had lots of ice cream and toppings that we served to approx 50 people who attended including two van loads of residents from DLC. We sold 43 tix at \$10 each for a total of \$430 collected which was sent to Area. Our expenses were \$181.81 (of which \$75 was rent to TLC) for a net to Area of \$248.19

Our next event is Get Baked the NA Way to be held here on Easter 4/20 at 4:20pm during which we are hoping to have groups offer baked goods to be judged for prizes. We will also have games and an Easter egg hunt. Please tell your groups and anyone who wants to bake about the event.

We are also working on the details for our Area's Unity Day ... "beach" or not is to be determined. While Wiggins Pass has reopened, it has not fully recovered and right now the pavilion we'd used in the past is not open. We are looking at other venues.

The Area Policy Subcommittee met this morning with two in attendance, myself and the RCM. Updated policy pages were printed and distributed at the ASC. The Annual Policy Workshop was a success with nine engaged and participating members in attendance. Policy was reimbursed \$107.45 for workshop refreshments and incidentals. The Last Connection (not affiliated with Narcotics Anonymous) was reimbursed \$25.00 for an hour's use of the facility.

We have decided to write up a motion to add to the policy, that will extend to the entire area, that members handling funds must have a minimum of one year clean. We had further discussion, which included the PR chair, about updating certain items in Policy that may be erroneous or outdated in the helpline section. We will have another look at the literature section before the next meeting as well.

We will also be writing an initial motion to extend terms of service for certain ASC positions. We will have something in writing to present at the next ASC.
